HarFest 2018


The Norfolk harvest fayre is on Saturday 6th October.

It is **free** to go and look round this special Christmas market.


It is open 10am to 5pm on Thursday 30th November, Friday 1st December and Saturday 2nd December.


This is a music concert so it will be quite loud. It costs **£33** for a ticket which is a lot so it could be a present or a treat.
