This is a friendly place to get information, and advice on social things


You can make an appointment for free to speak to someone or just pop in for help with all different issues.

#### Time and Tide museum

This is where you can learn about life in Great Yarmouth in the past

This museum has lots of different things to look at. Over the summer there is a special display showing how people used to be looked after when they were ill.

You have to pay to go into the museum. It is £5.90 for disabled people but if you go at 3.30pm you can get a twilight ticket for £2 which gives you 1 hour to look round.

If you need a carer to go with you they get in for free.
